- be dropped or substituted
- be suspended from training
- be required to leave the Club.

For training and matches, I will:

- arrive on time with footwear suitable for the surface, shin guards, socks,
- wear Club tracksuit (for travel), full Mechanics' strip (for games)
- have a named water-bottle with sufficient liquid for my needs.
